### 6.5.1: Institution has a streamlined Internal Quality Assurance Mechanism

In 2021, an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established inside the institution.

In the aftermath of a pandemic, when admissions were delayed and exams were lengthened, the idea was novel and cells continue to have challenges with some aspects.

The cell was established in accordance with established protocols, and its members comprise a chairman, an appointed coordinator (one teacher), and representatives from administration, faculty, students, alumni, industry, and non-governmental organisations (NGOs) from other institutions.

Topics like "Importance," "Need," "How the peers are doing" (a very small number), "changes in Assessment & Accreditation process," and similar ones tend to dominate conversations in the first stages. As far as decisions go, this was more of a debate piece. The group found that after two or three sessions, they could have more productive discussions.

A group of people began to form in order to tackle the Quality Delivery project.

Through its decentralised committee structure, the IQAC ensures that academic and administrative activities are of high quality. The next step was to examine the procedures from a quality perspective. Some changes were made, and new methods were used. Informal office commands, adoption of standard operating procedures, awareness encounters, posters, and most importantly, decision practice institutionalised the alterations.

Improving the academic and administrative performance of the institution and promoting measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalising of quality culture and institutionalising of best practices are the goals of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the institute. They have been working on this system for some time now.

Key accomplishments of IQAC include:

Improving the college-wide LAN infrastructure for use in all departments' smart classrooms.

Building a Learning Management System.

Implementation of information and communication technology (ICT) training courses and faculty development events.

The clinical skill laboratory was established.
