Id-AYU0327) for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder - reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Shree Dhaneshwari Manav Vikaas Mandal, Sou Shanatadevi Vedprakash Patil Ayurved College & Research Institute, Gat No. 421, hatta, tal- Basmat-431705, Nanded, Dit.- Hingoli, Maharashtra (Inst. Id-AYU0327)** inspection of your College was conducted on **06.09.2022 & 07.09.2022 on virtual mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional permission for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.**
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under, and on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the NCISM dated 16.03.2022.
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **Nineteenth Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **22.11.2022**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria. Hence Board decided to issue the Conditional permission for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.**
4. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to **grant conditional permission to** namely **Shree Dhaneshwari Manav Vikaas Mandal, Sou Shanatadevi Vedprakash Patil Ayurved College & Research Institute, Gat No. 421, hatta, tal- Basmat-431705, Nanded, Dit.- Hingoli, Maharashtra (Inst. Id-AYU0327) for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements:-
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT.**The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

- III. It is also informed that the determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in Private Medical Institutions and Deemed to be Universities should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref.no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of the respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
7. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2023-24:-**
- all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and
8. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.

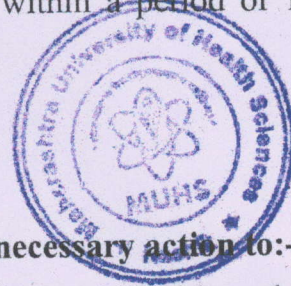
Sir / Madam,

As per provision of section 65(4) of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act 1998, I am directed to inform you that, on the basis of Local Inquiry Committee report, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor is pleased to grant the First Time Affiliation to **Shri. Dhaneshwari Manav Vikas Mandal's, Sau. Shantadevi Vedprakash Patil Ayurved College and Research Institute, Gut No. 421, at Hatta, Tal. Basmat, Dist. Hingoli (Maharashtra) for the Academic Year 2021-22 for Increase in Intake Capacity from 50 to 100 seats of B.A.M.S. (UG) course subject to approval of Academic Council as per the provision under section (65)2 of MUHS Act 1998 by following due procedure.**

However, the affiliation is subject to the following conditions: -

- 1) Fulfilment of norms and conditions laid down by Central Council of Indian Medicine / National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, (NCISM) and Govt. of India.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No. L.14014/177/2019-EP-(1) dated 08.06.2019 related to admission matter for the academic year 2019-20, intimating certain requirements to be fulfilled by the college for consideration of permission for the academic session 2020-21.

2. Further, refer to the CCIM's letter No.Ref.3-3/2020-Ay. (83) dated 22.09.2020 forwarding therewith recommendation of the college to the Central Government based on thorough examination of the visitation report Part-I, indemnity bond, affidavit & latest details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the college along with the assessment report, as the physical verification by conduction of inspection could not be carried out in view of present COVID-19 pandemic situation for the A.Y. 2020-21. On examining the same, it is found that, the college is not fulfilling the requirement related to Website as specified in sub-regulation (2) of regulation 9 of RMS, 2016 and therefore, an opportunity for Hearing/Compliance to update the website by 07.10.2020 was granted to the college under the provision of IMCC Act, 1970.

3. The Compliance submitted by the college and recommendations & assessment report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government **to grant Conditional Permission to Shri Daneshwari Manav Mandal, Sou, Shantadevi Vedprakesh Patil Ayurved College & Research Institute, Gat No 421, Tq Basamati Distt. Hingoli, Maharashtra** for conducting 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the following:

- ii. 5. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 50 UG (BAMS) seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority of State/UT Government as designated by Central Government vide letter F.No.L.11011/02/2020-EP (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.

7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Board of Governors, CCIM and the Central Government.


8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2020 to get permission for the session 2021-22:

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R. 12011/16/2013-EP (IM-1) for 2018-19 dated 25.09.2018 related to denial of permission for the academic year 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic year 2019-20.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 10-11.04.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 28.05.2019 to present the case.

3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to **Shri Dhaneshwri Manav Vikas Mandal, Sou Shantadevi Vedprakash Patil Ayurved College & Research Institute, Gat No. 421, Tq. Basmati Dist. Hingoli, Maharashtra** for conducting 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to following conditions:


- i. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and

ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

- ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by 31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.03.2019 & 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.
5. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of 50 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
 - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*
9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.


