3.2.1: Institution has created an ecosystem for innovations including incubation centre and other initiatives for creation and transfer of knowledge

1. The institution has established the Research committee with the purpose of fostering an environment conducive to innovation and the generation and dissemination of knowledge.

2. The university has implemented many measures to foster the generation and dissemination of information to society, by creating a favorable atmosphere for research. BAMS students have the chance to enhance their understanding of cutting-edge technology in their area by participation in specialized workshops organized by the college in partnership with the pharmaceutical industry, Pharmacy College, Engineering College, Agriculture College, and topic specialists.

3. The college provides a workshop on Research Methodology to educate undergraduate students and an Advanced Research Methodology workshop to educate teaching faculty members engaged in scientific research.

4. Since 2018, the institution has formed an ethical committee consisting of distinguished individuals, in accordance with the norms set by CCIM, NCISM, and MUHS. This group periodically organizes courses on research methods. In light of this influential direction, new graduate courses are being introduced to expand the scientific foundations of Ayurveda in order to foster curiosity in the modern world.

5. According to the criteria set by MUHS in 2018-19, our institution has established a Research Advisory Committee (RAC) for the students. These committees oversee the approval of synopses.

6. The institution has established an Incubation Cell in the same region. These facilities include research workshops, guest lectures, authorization for medication development, and other necessary components to promote creative start-ups.

7. Students of the Department of Rognidan Avum Vikruti Vigyan are required to apply their knowledge from the curriculum in innovative ways. Students gather data from several sources,

including websites, books, journals, and research papers. This enhances their curiosity in the topic and fosters originality and ingenuity. The students must provide research data in a sequential manner inside the group, which eventually improves collaboration.

8. The museum of Swasthviritta and the yoga section showcases mudra models crafted from plaster of Paris using gloves. It imparts comprehensive understanding of various mudras to the pupils.

9. The Ras shastra department supplies the hospital with unique kits such as chavanprasha, shirodhara kit, and basti kit.
